

ITINERARY SUMMARY

Day 1 – Embarkation in Punta Arenas

Guests check in during the afternoon at Muelle Prat and embark in the early evening. After a welcome toast the ship sets sail south, navigating the Strait of Magellan and entering the channels of Patagonia and Tierra del Fuego.

Day 2 – Ainsworth Bay & Tuckers Islets. The ship arrives at Ainsworth Bay near Marinelli Glacier.

Guests explore the subantarctic Magellanic forest and learn about glacial retreat and ecosystem recovery. Zodiac navigation around Tuckers Islets allows observation of Magellanic penguins and seabirds. (In September and April, this excursion is replaced by a glacier walk in Brookes Bay.)

Day 3 – Pia Glacier & Avenue of the Glaciers

Navigation through the Beagle Channel leads to Pia Fjord, where guests disembark for a guided hike to a viewpoint overlooking Pia Glacier.

The day continues with scenic sailing along the renowned Avenue of the Glaciers, offering panoramic views directly from the ship.

Day 4 – Cape Horn & Wulaia Bay

Weather permitting, guests disembark at Cape Horn National Park, one of the southernmost points on Earth. In the afternoon, the ship visits Wulaia Bay, a historic Yamana settlement site, featuring a guided walk through Magellanic forest to a scenic viewpoint.
